Employment statistics 2016: What graduates do after the China-EU School of Law

95.5 % of the China-EU School of Law's graduates are employed or in further study three months after graduating. Most graduates find jobs in law firms in China.

Employment statistics in 2016:

In total, 111 students graduated in 2016: 65 double master's students, 36 Chinese Law master's students, 1 PhD student, 6 Chinese MEIL students and 3 international MEIL students.

Out of the 108 Chinese graduates in 2016, 94 directly found a job. 45 graduates signed a contract with a law firm (3 of them with an international law firm), 28 graduates were employed as civil servants or in public institutions, 14 graduates were employed by financial or insurance institutions, and 7 graduates worked as in-house-counselor in companies.

9 Chinese graduates decided to further study. Six chose universities abroad such as University of Bremen and Maastricht University. Three graduates enrolled as PhD students at the China University of Political Science and Law.

3 international graduates found work immediately as well. 2 joined public services, 1 works in a law firm.
